ALL FOUR ISC ROUNDS ON SATURDAY**

Combined scores from the DAWG Texas Hold 'Em ISC J3 Jumpers and Standard A3 classes on Saturday, January 25, 2025, will be used to award the Combined ISC Class Award and the World Team Tryouts Bye. To be eligible for the Combined ISC Class Award the team must have a minimum of one clean ISC run and a run that has a maximum of 5 course faults (no time faults allowed) for those scores to be used to compute the Combined Score. If the winning dog in any given jump height does not meet the FCI jump heights, the award **DOES NOT** go to the first eligible dog. If no FCI-eligible dog meets the requirements for Combined Class Award, the Bye award is not given. The Combined Class winners that meet the FCI jump height cut offs from the 12-, 16-, 20- and 24-inch heights are invited to attend the AKC/USA World Team Tryouts. They do not need to fulfill any other performance requirements. The team must send in all the required information with the fees and the entry form and meet all the other basic eligibility noted in the WTT document (including an approved pedigree). The handler at tryouts must be the same handler that won the Combined Class Award.

The winning teams must send in all the required information with the fees and the entry form and meet all the other basic eligibility as noted in the World Team Tryout Rules that can be found at <https://www.akc.org/sports/agility/events/usa-world-agility-team/>. The handler at tryouts must be the same handler that won the combined award.

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS FOR INTERNATIONAL SWEEPSTAKES CLASSES (ISC):

Purpose:

The International Sweepstakes Class (ISC) is a non-regular class providing the dog and handler an opportunity to demonstrate their advanced training and handling skills on various International Style Standard and Jumpers with Weaves courses. The rules for this class are generally based on international rules. The variety in International Agility course designs is very diverse, so handlers should be prepared to meet the "Challenge of the Day" when competing in the ISC class. The total challenge level may be easier, more difficult, or simply different from what is currently allowed in Excellent / Master Class. Complete rules for the ISC are available from the AKC Website (<http://www.akc.org>).

Eligibility:

This class is open to dogs that are eligible to compete in AKC agility trials.

Jump Heights:

Dogs may be entered in their regular jump heights, **however**, only those dogs running in the 12", 16" and 20" class that meet the FCI/ISC measuring cutoff (different than regular AKC cutoffs) or any dog entering the 24" jump height will be eligible for the direct invitation to World Team Tryouts. The FCI/ISC cutoffs for those heights are as follows:

- **Small (12" jump height) - for dogs 13-3/4" and under at the withers**
- **Medium (16" jump height) - for dogs 16-7/8" and under at the withers**
- **Intermediate (20" jump height) – for dogs 18-7/8" and under at the withers**
- **Large (24" jump height) - for dogs over 18-7/8" at the withers**

For Exhibition Only ("FEO") is allowed in all classes.

Prizes--ISC CLASSES-All 3 Days: First Place: Rose Rosette; Second Place: Brown Rosette; Third Place: Light Green Rosette; Fourth Place: Gray Rosette.

PRIZES FOR ISC CUP (SATURDAY): Dogs placing in the top 3 in each jump height will be awarded a dog toy valued at less than \$5. **To be eligible for the overall ISC Cup podium awards, you must enter all four ISC rounds on Saturday, January 25.** Runs will be scored time plus faults. All faults are 5 secs and eliminations are 100 secs. The top 3 combined winners per height will be on the podium and receive prizes. Preferred Dogs will be judged within their regular jump height.

JUMP HEIGHT CARD PROCESS

PLEASE DO NOT SEND A COPY OF YOUR JUMP HEIGHT CARD WITH YOUR ENTRY!

ENTRY FORM: If your dog needs to be measured, please check the box at the top of the entry form so your dog can be placed on the "To Be Measured" list.

All agility dogs are required to have an Official Jump Height Card/Valid yellow form and exhibitors must be able to present it at any time during the trial **upon request**. All dogs that have not been officially measured for an Agility Jump Height Card may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. If measured by the Judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial *or back-to-back trials* only. However, if a **Volunteer Measuring Official (VMO)** or an **Agility Field Rep** is present; **ALL** dogs without a valid Jump Height Card/Form **must** be measured at some time during the trial or cluster of trials. **If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog measured prior to running and failure to do so will result in the cancellation of any qualifying scores.**

TRIAL HOURS

The trial site is available no less than 1 hour prior to the first run each day. Judging will begin no earlier than 8 a.m. Exact running order will be determined after entries close and will be provided in the Judging Program.

ENTRY INFORMATION

YOU MAY ENTER THE TRIAL VIA LABTESTED ONLINE SERVICE

This trial is accepting online entries through LabTestedOnline.com. During the first 48 hours after opening, the initial limit of entries designated as either online or paper will be as follows. 350 runs online (50%), 350 runs paper (50%) each day. If either form of entry has not filled at the end of the 48-hour time period, the club reserves the right to decrease or increase either one accordingly.

*** Hand deliveries cannot be accepted during the first 24 hours after the trial's opening. ***

- Limit: 10 entries per envelope. One entry = one dog. Envelopes containing more than 10 entries will be returned.
- Paper entries received within 24 hours of the opening date & time must: 1) include postage or be metered; 2) be delivered by a multi-state or multi-national postal or carrier service, including but not limited to USPS, FedEx, UPS & DHL. If the above conditions are not met, the entries are not valid and must be returned to the sender. **You must waive signature requirements when using services that utilize signature verifications.**
- Owners are responsible for ensuring that entry forms are completed IN FULL. Entries submitted without ALL information will be returned as invalid.
- All entries must be submitted on official AKC agility entry forms, one dog per entry form. Photocopies of the entry form will be accepted only if legible and official AKC size.
- Entries will not be accepted without signature, fees and reverse side of entry form with agreement signed, nor will credit cards or faxed entries be accepted with paper entries.
- Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry; no refund for duplicate entries. There will be a \$25 service charge for returned checks.

PLEASE CHECK YOUR CONFIRMATIONS CAREFULLY!

We email confirmations, answer all correspondence, and acknowledge receipt of all move-ups and corrections to entries. We usually respond within 2 days or less unless we are at a trial. Please contact us at imagilitytx@gmail.com if you do not get your confirmation or hear back in a reasonable timeframe. **IF YOU DO NOT HEAR FROM US, WE DID NOT GET YOUR EMAIL OR ENTRY!**

REFUND POLICY

- Entry fees will be refunded if an entry is pulled before the closing date and time.
- No refunds will be made for any entry pulled after the closing date unless the spot is filled from someone on the wait list (see below).
- For bitches in season, the club will provide refunds less \$5 per day for the first 2 runs; plus \$3 per run for each additional run each day. The Trial Secretary must be notified in writing no later than 30 minutes before the start of the trials. Refunds will be mailed after the trial. The club reserves the right to require further proof at its discretion.
- Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, sick, lame, excused by veterinarian or judge, barred from competition by action of the Event Committee, is ineligible to compete due to being entered incorrectly or if a trial cannot open or be completed.
- Refunds of less than \$5 will not be made.
- Entry fees will not be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.

WAIT LIST – REFUND POLICY

In the event the trial fills, we are offering a Wait List to fill openings created by withdrawn entries after the trial's closing date/time. A maximum of FIFTY (50) entries will be placed on the club's wait list. **All entries, including wait listed entries, must be received by the Trial Secretary prior to the trial closing date as listed on the front of this Premium. Any withdrawals that are received by 6 p.m. the Sunday prior to the first day of the trial will be replaced by a wait listed entry if any are available.** If a withdrawn entry is replaced by a wait listed entry, a full refund will be issued for the withdrawn entry. Any wait listed entry that does not move off the wait list into the trial by 6 pm the Sunday prior to the first day of the trial will receive a full refund.

ELIGIBILITY

All dogs fifteen (15) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) or an AKC Canine Partners listing number, or approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds are eligible to participate. Refer to Chapter 2 of the Registration and Discipline Rules for the listing of registerable breeds that may participate. Wherever the word "dog" is used in these regulations, it includes both sexes. Dogs with a Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) or an AKC Canine Partners listing number must be spayed or neutered in order to compete.

Dogs should be physically sound. Dogs that are blind shall not be eligible, and neither are bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance. No dog shall compete if it is taped or bandaged in any way or has anything attached to it for medical purposes.

SET-UP

Exhibitors are allowed to set up at least 1 hour prior to the first run.

CRATING INFORMATION

- No crating on concrete around the ring.
- Main crating will be in the smaller dirt arena behind the main arena.
- Limited crating will be available on the dirt next to the AKC ring.
- 10x10 stalls available to rent \$25/day. Please call 903-287-9501 for stall reservations.

RING DIMENSIONS & SURFACE

Ring 1 (ISC) is 115' x 110' and Ring 2 is 115' X 100'. The trial is held indoors on packed dirt in a limited-climate-controlled arena (there are overhead heaters). This set of trials may use electronic timers.

ARMBANDS NOT REQUIRED

Pursuant to Chapter 1, Section 19 of the Regulations for Agility Trials as amended in July 2016, competitors will NOT be required to wear armband stickers.

ENTRY CONFIRMATIONS & JUDGING PROGRAM

An email confirmation will be sent at the time of processing if a legible, valid email address is provided on the entry form. Additional confirmations will be emailed to acknowledge move-ups and corrections/changes (prior to closing). A final confirmation and the judging program will be emailed after the trial closes. If you cannot receive a Microsoft Word text file, or if you do not check your email, do NOT include your email address. Printed confirmations and Judging Programs are mailed to exhibitors without email addresses after the trial closes. **OWNERS/HANDLERS ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR REVIEWING ALL INFORMATION IN THE CONFIRMATION LETTER EACH TIME IT IS SENT AND CONTACTING THE TRIAL SECRETARY IMMEDIATELY IN WRITING (EMAIL) IF A CORRECTION OR CHANGE NEEDS TO BE MADE. CORRECT AKC REGISTRATION # OR ILP # IS CRUCIAL.**

NOTE: If you have a spam filter in place on your email account, please add the trial secretary's email address to your accepted address list. If you are not receiving emails from the trial secretary, it is your responsibility to notify the trial secretary to reach a resolution.

Any exhibitor who does not receive a preliminary confirmation within 10 days of mailing a paper entry should contact the Trial Secretary to confirm receipt of paper entry.

Any exhibitor who does not receive the Judging Program within five (5) days prior to the trial, should contact the Trial Secretary. Always bring a paper copy of your confirmation letter to the trial. Corrections to the confirmation letter that are not brought to the trial secretary's attention at the time of receipt will render the database as the final authority for the day's information.

AWARDS (EXCLUDING ISC RUNS)

Ribbons/Rosettes: REGULAR CLASSES: Rosettes will be awarded to the 1st through 4th place dogs in each STD, JWW, and Premier class in each jump height. Qualifying ribbons will be awarded to dogs receiving a qualifying score in regular classes only. Dogs must qualify to receive a placement ribbon. New Title rosettes will be available for new titles earned at this trial. MACH and PACH Rosettes, along with a MACH/PACH bar will be available for dogs earning those titles at this trial. A special AGCH Rosette is offered for those earning the Agility Grand Championship at this trial

MOVE-UPS

Dogs may be moved up to a higher class at the request of the owner, as a result of qualifying for an agility title, provided that the request is received in writing by the Trial Secretary, no later than 6 pm on the Monday preceding the event. (See the move-up deadline date on the cover of this premium). Day-to-day move ups are allowed provided the Trial Secretary is notified at the show site, in writing within 30 minutes of the last dog completing the course. Forms will be available at the show site.

NOTICE TO NOVICE EXHIBITORS

(Effective June 1, 2010) A dog which has been entered in a Novice "A" class for which it is not eligible to be entered in due to class restrictions on the dog or handler may be moved to the Novice "B" class under the following conditions:

- The request for the move must be in writing and presented to the superintendent or trial secretary at least 30 minutes prior to the start of each trial;
- The request must state the reason and justification for the move from a Novice "A" class to the Novice "B" class

EXHIBITOR INFORMATION

- Pinch/prong and electrical collars (dummy or not), head halters and special training collars are not allowed on trial grounds.
- Handlers are permitted to walk the course, without a dog, prior to the start of the class. Each walk-through is restricted to handlers entered in that class/jump height.
- Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases and have appropriate vaccinations.
- Running order will be determined by computer-generated random draw. Handlers with multiple dogs in one class will have those dogs separated as much as possible.
- All dogs present **must** be on leash or confined in crates when not being judged or at the warm up jump.
- Free parking is available for exhibitors. Park at your own risk.
- Exhibitors may wear shirts or insignia of their training group.
- The safety of the dogs is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all the obstacles safely.
- The Club and the Trial Secretary have no obligation or responsibility to provide a public

address system or stewards to call or locate dogs that are not present at the ring when required. Exhibitors are responsible for being at the gate when it is their turn to run.

- The Club and the Trial Facility assume no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers or to any of their dogs or property and further assume no responsibility for injury to children.
- Exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Event Committee, be asked to leave the trial site. No refund of entry fees will be made.

Dogs **may not** be left overnight at the trial site.

FEO AND FIX AND GO ON

As of January 1, 2021 For Exhibition only (FEO) and Fix and Go On are permanent parts of the AKC Agility program.

Entering For Exhibition Only (FEO)

- At the option of the club, a handler may choose to change any class entry into a For Exhibition Only (FEO) run. The handler must notify the scribe and the judge as they enter the ring prior to the start of the run that they are doing an FEO run. The scribe sheet shall be marked "FEO", no time "NT", and "E" for an excused, nonqualifying run. Maximum Courses Time for FEO shall be 45 seconds for all classes, except for FAST which will use the set FAST course times. Allowing FEO runs is at the option of the club. Clubs must allow ALL classes to be run as FEO if they choose to offer this option. It must be stated in the premium and any pre-trial publications.
- FEO runs are treated as trial entries. The exhibitor must enter the class(es) (T2B and/or FAST) prior to the closing date, pay class entry fee(s) and the Trial Secretary must record the entry in the Trial Catalog as part of the results for that class. FEO does not need to be noted on the entry form; the handler will declare the day of the show.
- Dogs may be entered in any jump height for FEO runs. If entered in an ineligible jump height, the team is committed to FEO for that run and must declare FEO on the start line. Day of show jump height changes are not allowed.
- Dogs may be entered in any level of FAST (Novice, Open, Excellent, Master). If the dog is not eligible for the level entered, the team is committed to FEO for that run and must declare FEO on the start line. Day of show level changes are not allowed.
- The exhibitor must declare FEO in the ring prior to leading out. FEO may be declared earlier (ex. when checking in at the gate board).

Fix and Go On (FNG)

Fix and Go On is not pre-entered; rather, it occurs during the course of the run.

FNG allows exhibitors to immediately reattempt an obstacle at any time while on course when the dog's performance of an obstacle is not to their expectation. This allows the dog to successfully complete the obstacle then finish the course or leave the ring on a positive note. Using FNG will result in a non-qualifying score.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an Agility Jump Height Card may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. If measured by the Judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial or back-to-back trials only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.
