We will be utilizing the AGILITY GATE APP for convenient check-in and gate management.

Agility Gate is a free-to-download app that allows competitors to check-in their dogs via their mobile phone or tablet at an agility show and keep track of the current state of the run orders. It helps prevent crowding around the gate and allows competitors to keep tabs on things while crating away from the ring or away from the show site.

The access code is 1010.

Course maps will be posted at the trial site. You can take a picture of the posted maps or download a copy to your phone using the Agility Gate app. Paper copies of the maps will not be available.

Arrival/Setup

You may begin setting up at 6:30 am all three days. We will start unloading the trailer at 6:30 am Friday morning. If anyone would like to help, it would be greatly appreciated. You'll get to set up a little early PLUS you'll get Worker Coupons!

DOGS MAY NOT BE LEFT AT THE SHOW SITE OVERNIGHT.

Measuring

All agility dogs are required to have an Official Jump Height Card and must be able to present it if asked. Don't forget to bring your height card in case someone asks for it.

Neither judge is a Volunteer Measuring Official (VMO). Unless an AKC Rep is present (not expected), there will not be a Measuring Official at this trial. Measurements will not be official -- it is only to make sure you are in the correct jump height for this weekend. All exhibitors who do not have a permanent height card or temporary (yellow) measurement form must be measured before running (unless you're jumping 24"). Measurements will be taken all day between classes. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog measured prior to running.

Check-In (Armbands Not Required)

Pursuant to Chapter 1, Section 19 of the Regulations for Agility Trials (Revised July 2016), the club will not be requiring the use of armband stickers, so traditional checkin is not required.

No paper check-in will be required. We will be using the **Agility Gate App** for check-in from your phone ... see left sidebar for more information.

Running orders and Course Maps

A running order will be posted on <u>imagilityservices.com</u> 3-4 days prior to the first day of the trial.

Course maps will be posted at the trial site per AKC Agility Regulations. Please take a picture of the posted maps for access on your phone or tablet. Maps will also be posted on the Agility Gate App.

Move-ups:

The pretrial move-up deadline is **Monday, November 25 at 6 p.m.** Please email the trial secretary on or before that date/time for a move up for the trial.

Day-to-day move-ups are permitted at the trials. You must fill out a move-up form (available at the check-in table) at any time, but no later than 20 minutes after the last dog crosses the finish line on Saturday for a Sunday move-up. Please give all move-up forms to the trial secretary.

She is a certified Canine Therapeutic Massage Therapist (CTMT) and Certified Canine Trigger Point Massage Therapist (CTrPMT).



The Trial Site

The town of McKinney is about 33 miles north of downtown Dallas on U.S. 75/North Central Expressway. From the north or south: On U.S. 75, take the U.S. 380 exit and go west about 2.5 miles to FM1461. Turn right (north) on FM1461 and travel approximately 2.9 miles to County Road 166. Turn right (north) on County Road 166 and go 0.8 (8/10) mile to the site which is on the left. The county has posted directional signs to the Event Center.
