We will be utilizing the **AGILITY GATE APP for** convenient check-in and gate management.

Agility Gate is a free-to-download app that allows competitors to check-in their dogs via their mobile phone or tablet at an agility show and keep track of the current state of the run orders. It helps prevent crowding around the gate and allows competitors to keep tabs on things while crating away from the ring or away from the show site.

The access code is 1010.

Course maps will be posted at the trial site. You can take a picture of the posted maps or download a copy to your phone using the Agility Gate app. Paper copies of the maps will not be available.

PLEASE CHECK IN **EACH MORNING FOR ALL YOUR CLASSES**

Arrival/Setup

The show site will be available to exhibitors on Friday at 7:30 AM. The building will be vacated nightly at 7:30 PM.

Exhibitors who help course build on Friday morning may setup at 6:30 AM. All other exhibitors can setup after 7:30 AM on Friday, NO SETUP ON THURSDAY, this includes dropping off crates and personal items.

DOGS MAY NOT BE LEFT AT THE SHOW SITE OVERNIGHT.

Measuring

All agility dogs are required to have an Official Jump Height Card and must be able to present it if asked. Don't forget to bring your height card in case someone asks for it.

A Volunteer Measuring Official (VMO) will NOT be at this trial, so there will no official measurements. If you do NOT have a permanent height card you will still need get an unofficial measurement to ensure you are in the correct jump height for this weekend

All exhibitors who do not have a permanent height card or temporary (yellow) measurement form must be measured BEFORE running (unless you're jumping 24"). Measurements will be taken all day between classes. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog measured prior to running.

Check-In (Armbands Not Required)

Pursuant to Chapter 1, Section 19 of the Regulations for Agility Trials (Revised July 2016), the club will not be requiring the use of armband stickers, so traditional checkin is not required.

No paper check-in will be required. We will be using the Agility Gate App for checkin from your phone ... see left sidebar for more information.

Running orders

A running order will be posted on **imagilityservices.com** 3-4 days prior to the first day of the trial.

Concessions ...

On-site concessions will be available all three days. Outside food is allowed, but outside alcohol is prohibited.

Course Maps

Course maps will be posted at the trial site per AKC Agility Regulations. Please take a picture of the posted maps for access on your phone or tablet. Maps will also be posted on the Agility Gate App.

We will have sign-up sheets at the check-in table for volunteers to write your name down where you are willing to work.

This should eliminate conflicts and give you a chance to choose your job. Fill it out early to grab the spot you want.

Workers will receive worker bucks for each class worked.

The Chief Ring Stewards will distribute the vouchers. Make sure to get them before you leave the trial. None will be mailed after the trial.

Move-ups:

The pretrial move-up deadline is **Monday**, **May 4 at 6 PM**. Please email the trial secretary on or before that date/time for a move up for the trial.
