We will be utilizing the AGILITY GATE APP for convenient check-in and gate management.

Agility Gate is a free-to-download app that allows competitors to check-in their dogs via their mobile phone or tablet at an agility show and keep track of the current state of the run orders. It helps prevent crowding around the gate and allows competitors to keep tabs on things while crating away from the ring or away from the show site.

The access code is 2025.

Course maps will be posted at the trial site. You can take a picture of the posted maps or download a copy to your phone using the Agility Gate app. Paper copies of the maps will not be available.

Arrival/Setup

The show site will be available to exhibitors on **Monday at 7:30 AM**. The building will be vacated nightly.

Exhibitors who help setup equipment on Sunday may drop off crates and personal items. Please contact the trial chair for information.

DOGS MAY NOT BE LEFT AT THE SHOW SITE OVERNIGHT.

Measuring

All agility dogs are required to have an Official Jump Height Card and must be able to present it if asked. Don't forget to bring your height card in case someone asks for it.

Two VMOs, Carrie DeYoung and Sue Fregien, will be available to measure on both days of the trial). ALL dogs (regardless of height) without a permanent Jump Height Card or Yellow "Temporary Measurement" Form (for dogs under 2 years old) must be measured before their first run of the weekend. Forms will be available. Please fill out a form before asking to be measured. If you already have a permanent height card, be sure to have it with you at the trial in case you are asked for it. If your dog needs to be measured, it is your responsibility to have it done before you run. Failure to do so will result in the removal of any qualifying runs you receive.

Check-In (Armbands Not Required)

Pursuant to Chapter 1, Section 19 of the Regulations for Agility Trials (Revised July 2016), the club will not be requiring the use of armband stickers, so traditional checkin is not required.

No paper check-in will be required. We will be using the **Agility Gate App** for check-in from your phone ... see left sidebar for more information.

Running orders

A running order will be posted on <u>imagilityservices.com</u> 3-4 days prior to the first day of the trial.

Concessions ...

On-site concessions will be available both days. Outside food is allowed, but outside alcohol is prohibited.

Course Maps

Course maps will be posted at the trial site per AKC Agility Regulations. Please take a picture of the posted maps for access on your phone or tablet. Maps will also be posted on the Agility Gate App.

Move-ups:

The pretrial move-up deadline is **Monday**, **May 26 at 6 PM**. Please email the trial secretary on or before that date/time for a move up for the trial.

Day-to-day move-ups are permitted at the trials. You must fill out a move-up form (available at the check-in table) at any time, but no later than 20 minutes after the last dog crosses the finish line on Monday for a Tuesday move-up. Please give all move-up forms to the trial secretary.

PLEASE REMEMBER ...

Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dogs immediately on hotel/motel and show grounds. Motels/hotels require that dogs be crated when unattended; no bathing or grooming of dogs in guest rooms. Exhibitors/handlers are responsible for any damage to motels/hotels or the event site and may result in disciplinary action by the Event Committee. Entries may be refused in the future for previous misuse of the motel or show facilities. This is an AKC-supported measure.
