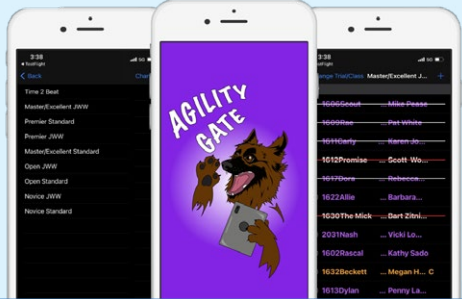

AGILITY GATE APP for
convenient check-in
and gate management.**

Agility Gate is a free-to-download app that allows competitors to check-in their dogs via their mobile phone or tablet at an agility show and keep track of the current state of the run orders. It helps prevent crowding around the gate and allows competitors to keep tabs on things while crating away from the ring or away from the show site.

Arrival/Setup

There will be no early exhibitor setup on Friday. **You may beginning setting up at 6:30 AM on Saturday and Sunday.**

DOGS MAY NOT BE LEFT AT THE SHOW SITE OVERNIGHT.

IMPORTANT: Unloading/Loading on Saturday & Sunday will NOT be permitted through the overhead door on the west side of the arena. Unloading/Loading will have to be done through the north doors/ramps to the arena on Burnett-Tandy Drive.

Parking

WATT ARENA CHARGES A \$15.00 PARKING FEE EACH DAY. This is a City of Fort Worth fee, not a club fee. Park at your own risk. The club is not responsible for theft or damage. Please do not leave dogs or any valuables in your vehicle at any time. The Trial Committee reserves the right to take whatever measures are necessary to rescue animals in distress. Purchase your daily or multi-day parking pass at the gate. More details are available in the premium.

Measuring

All agility dogs are required to have an Official Jump Height Card and must be able to present it if asked. Don't forget to bring your height card in case someone asks for it.

A Volunteer Measuring Official (VMO) will **NOT** be at this trial, so there will no official measurements. If you do NOT have a permanent height card you will still need get an unofficial measurement to ensure you are in the correct jump height for this weekend.

All exhibitors who do not have a **permanent height card** or **temporary (yellow) measurement form** must be measured **BEFORE** running (unless you're jumping 24"). Measurements will be taken all day between classes. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog measured prior to running.

Running Orders and Course Maps

A running order will be posted on jmagilityservices.com 3-4 days prior to the first day of the trial.

Course maps will be posted at the trial site per AKC Agility Regulations. Please take a picture of the posted maps for access on your phone or tablet. Maps will also be posted on the Agility Gate App.

Check-In *(Armbands Not Required)*

Pursuant to Chapter 1, Section 19 of the Regulations for Agility Trials, the club will not be requiring the use of armband stickers, so traditional check-in is not required.

No paper check-in will be required. We will be using the **Agility Gate App** for check in from your phone ... see left sidebar for more information.

Move-ups

The pretrial move-up deadline is **Monday, June 8, 2026 at 6 PM**. Please email the trial secretary (jmagilitytx@gmail.com) on or before that date/time for a move up for the trial.

Day-to-day move-ups are permitted at the trials. You must fill out a move-up form (available at the results table) at any time, but no later than 30 minutes after the last dog crosses the finish line on Saturday for a Sunday move-up. Please give all move-up forms to the trial secretary.

Awards

Awards will be self-serve. Rosettes will be awarded to the 1st through 4th place dogs in each Standard, JWW (including Premier), and FAST class and 1st place in each T2B class in each jump height. Qualifying ribbons will be awarded to dogs receiving a qualifying score. Dogs must qualify to receive a placement ribbon. New Title rosettes will be available for new titles earned at this trial. MACH and PACH Rosettes and a MACH/PACH pole will be available for dogs earning those titles at this trial. The first-place winners will receive a discount coupon for a future DCNT agility trial. An AGCH Rosette will be available for dogs who earn that title at this trial. Awards must be claimed at the trial; none will be mailed.

Concessions

Concessions will be available for lunch all 3 days during the trial. The concession stand will not be open for breakfast. **Sorry, outside food is not allowed.**

DIRECTIONS TO THE PARC: Exit the show site by going left on Trail Dr. Turn south (right) on University Dr to I-30 W. In approximately 8/10 of a mile, turn right onto West Freeway. Merge onto I-30 West. In approx. .23 miles, take Exit 10 toward Hulen St. Stay on West Freeway and exit (turn left) onto Merrick St. Turn left over freeway and turn left onto the Eastbound service road. The PARC is located on the south side of I-30 east of Merrick St. (Approximately 5- 10 minutes from show site) on the right.

Exhibitors are responsible for being at the ring when their turn is called. Neither the Club nor the Judges will be responsible for the start times. Please plan your arrival accordingly.
