Trial Hours:

Building Opens @ 6:45 AM – Walk@ 8:15 AM - Judging Starts @ **8:30 AM**

Briefings: We won't have a general briefing, but the trial committee and judge are happy to answer any questions. Briefings will be held for all games classes.

Checking in: There is no check-in.

Day-of-Show Entries: We will accept day-of-show entries for \$18 per run, \$36 per Master Series. You may enter throughout the day for any classes you have not entered.

Mulligan Runs: Mulligan runs may be offered, depending on day-of-show entry numbers. You must be entered in the Agility or Jumping classes to purchase and participate in a Mulligan run.

The cost is **\$5 for 60 seconds in the ring**. Mulligan runs **do not count toward a Q**. They are simply an opportunity to try different handling, train a missed contact, bring in a toy, or work on anything else you choose during your time.

Note: If day-of-show entries are high, Mulligan runs may be cancelled to ensure we vacate the building by the contracted time.

Not for Competition Runs (NFC): You may turn any run into an NFC run, but you must declare this **immediately before entering the ring**. You may use any type of toy (**no food and no clickers**). You are welcome to use the run for any type of training, as long as you are not harsh, abusive, or overly corrective toward your dog.

You may use the SCT to repeat any piece of equipment as many times as needed. If you choose to train the start line, timing will begin once the handler starts walking back toward the dog.

An additional person may accompany you in the ring to assist with training. You may also bring training aids such as mats, but they **cannot** be placed on the equipment.

You **must** leave the ring immediately once your time is up.

Repeat and Move On: During a run, a competitor may immediately repeat any obstacle one time at the competitor's discretion. This is an immediate elimination. In so doing, the competitor may repeat one or a maximum of two relevant preceding obstacle(s) prior to the point of error if it is beneficial to their performance of the obstacle. If the error is a knocked bar, a competitor may reset a maximum of 1 jump bar. The handler can either continue to work the remainder of the course in normal competitive spirit or immediately head to the exit of the ring.

Entering the ring: Flat buckle collars without dangles are allowed in the ring. You may bring your toy into the ring and drop it at the start line along with your leash.

Crating: There is plenty of crating space in the building on either side of the ring.

Measuring Dogs: [UKI 11th Edition Rule Book.pdf](#)

If a dog is under 3 years old and newly registered, a temporary measure or proof of height must be completed by the dog's 3rd trial. A permanent measure must then be obtained from an official UKI measurer between 12–18 months after the first temporary measure. Any registered dog with only a temporary measure must follow this requirement.

If a newly registered dog is over 3 years old, an official UKI measurement must be completed by the dog's 3rd trial, and this measurement will be permanent.

If you request a challenge measure for a dog that already has a permanent measure, you must state this at the time of measuring so the correct protocol is followed. A permanent measure may only be challenged once.

Volunteers: This is a small trial and volunteers are appreciated. Workers will receive DAWG dollars as appreciation for your help. They can be used at any upcoming DAWG events or training classes. Here is the link to the worker schedule:

Online Results: All clear/qualifying results will be available to view on the UKI site within three weeks of the trial. You will be able to log in to your account and see results that were clear rounds, gaining Level points.
