



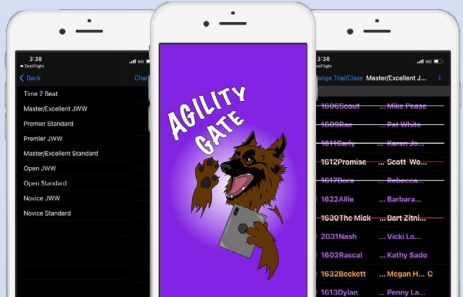

We will be utilizing the **AGILITY GATE APP** for convenient check-in and gate management.

Agility Gate is a free-to-download app that allows competitors to check-in their dogs via their mobile phone or tablet at an agility show and keep track of the current state of the run orders. It helps prevent crowding around the gate and allows competitors to keep tabs on things while crating away from the ring or away from the show site.

The access code is 1010.

Course maps will be posted at the trial site. You can take a picture of the posted maps or download a copy to your phone using the Agility Gate app. Paper copies of the maps will not be available.

Daylight Savings Reminder!

It's that time again—we lose an hour on Saturday night. **Be sure to set your clocks one hour ahead on Saturday night so you'll arrive on time Sunday morning!**

Arrival/Setup

There will be no early exhibitor setup on Thursday, March 5 except for volunteers helping to **unload the trailer at 2 PM**. You may set up on Thursday **IF you help unload the trailer**. We can always use help! Thank you!

The building opens at 6:30 AM all three days. DOGS MAY NOT BE LEFT AT THE SHOW SITE OVERNIGHT.

Measuring

All agility dogs are required to have an Official Jump Height Card and must be able to present it if asked. Don't forget to bring your height card in case someone asks for it.

A Volunteer Measuring Official (VMO) will **NOT** be at this trial, so there will no official measurements. If you do NOT have a permanent height card you will still need get an unofficial measurement to ensure you are in the correct jump height for this weekend.

All exhibitors who do not have a **permanent height card** or **temporary (yellow) measurement form** must be measured **BEFORE** running (unless you're jumping 24"). Measurements will be taken all day between classes. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog measured prior to running.

Running Orders and Course Maps

A running order will be posted on magilityservices.com 3-4 days prior to the first day of the trial.

Course maps will be posted at the trial site per AKC Agility Regulations. Please take a picture of the posted maps for access on your phone or tablet. Maps will also be posted on the Agility Gate App.

Move-ups

The pretrial move-up deadline is **Monday, March 2 at 6 PM**. Please email the trial secretary (jmagilitytx@gmail.com) on or before that date/time for a move up for the trial.

Day-to-day move-ups are permitted at the trials. You must fill out a move-up form (available at the check-in table) at any time, but no later than 20 minutes after the last dog crosses the finish line on Saturday for a Sunday move-up. Please give all move-up forms to the trial secretary.

The town of McKinney is about 33 miles north of downtown Dallas on U.S. 75/North Central Expressway. From the north or south: On U.S. 75, take the U.S. 380 exit and go west about 2.5 miles to FM1461. Turn right (north) on FM1461 and travel approximately 2.9 miles to County Road 166. Turn right (north) on County Road 166 and go 0.8 (8/10) mile to the site which is on the left. The county has posted directional signs to the Event Center.
